

POINT IN TIME RESULTS FILE FORMAT GUIDELINES – VERSION 5

PURPOSE: The PIT Results File Format was created to support the compilation and sharing of results from the Point-In-Time Counts. The PIT Report Generation Tool and the public-facing PIT dashboards created by Simtech both leverage this common format.

The following are the labels that Simtech Solutions Inc. has chosen to use for their Point in Time Results Exchange Format for the HUD Point in Time count. These labels should be used as column headers in a CSV file with the results directly below them.

The full list of fields, which include a sample results file, can be found in [this Excel workbook](#). While this is a single, flat file the table itself is divided into three main types of data:

- 1) Meta data - The meta data elements, which are shown below, elaborate on how each of the results strings are to be classified. This additional information enables a single file format to be used for a multitude of purposes, including:
 - a. Compiling results from various data sources to produce a CoC-wide report.
 - b. Publishing results for year-over-year PIT trend analysis. These results can then be rendered in [Formal PIT Evaluation Dashboards](#).
 - c. Monthly Census figures generated from [the By-Name-List](#).
 - d. Daily Bed Census such as what is shown in [this stay pattern analysis](#).
- 2) PIT Count Results – These are the count figures for each of the table shells.
- 3) Weighting Factor Data Elements - This information is used to derive weighting factors for each of these responses, which can be used to enumerate the overall count estimates.

While the HUD Data Standards do not have project types for Safe Parking or Safe Sleeping, these have been added to allow for these projects to be ignored from any geographic sampling and enumeration and for them to be included within community resource directories. This approach allows for the data to still be aggregated into the Unsheltered column of the PIT report but disaggregated for local planning purposes. 3. Weighting Factor Data Elements

The *PIT Results File Format* was updated to include the following additional fields. Note that each of these will be limited to Adults Only. This information is used to derive weighting factors for each of these responses, which can be used to enumerate the overall count estimates.

AdultObservationResponses: The total number of Observation Tallies gathered.

AdultInterviewResponses: The total number of Unsheltered Surveys conducted.

NonBlank_CH: Adults who were interviewed and responded with Yes or No to Developmental Disability or HIV/AIDS, OR and any adults with “Yes” to any of the other disabling condition questions (or alcohol, drugs, or both for the *SubstanceAbuse* question) with Yes or No to the following “long and indefinite” question OR “No” to any of the disabling condition questions.

NonBlank_Vet: Adults who were interviewed that responded with either Yes or No to the Veteran Status question.

NonBlank_Mental: Adults who were interviewed who responded with “Yes” to the mental illness question and either Yes or No to the long and indefinite question OR who responded No to the mental illness question.

NonBlank_Substance: Adults who were interviewed who responded with “Alcohol”, “Drugs”, or “Both” to the Substance Abuse question and either Yes or No to the long and indefinite question OR who responded No to the Substance Abuse question.

NonBlank_HIV: Adults who were interviewed who responded with either “Yes” or “No” to the HIV/AIDS question.

NonBlank_DV: This is the count of all adults who were interviewed who indicated either “No” to the question of “Are you a victim of Domestic Violence?” or Yes to this question and a response of either “Yes” or “No” to the question of “Are you Currently Fleeing this situation?”
